



PARTS MANUAL





Security



Locate this symbol - it could save your life

This symbol is the standard safety symbol. You will find it on most of the decals on your equipment. It is also used throughout this manual.

This symbol is used mainly to draw your attention and to warn you of possible dangers and/or potential injuries.

It is vital that you read and understand completely the following instructions and safety rules prior to using your equipment.



The safety symbol accompanied by the word " DANGER" indicates an immediate danger capable of causing serious injury or death.

- 3 Do not allow passengers on the land leveler or tractor.
- 4 Do not remove protective guards or shields Ensure they are in place and properly attached.
- 5 Clear the area of all people, especially small children, prior to engaging the land leveler and/or the tractor.
- 6 Be extremely cautious while servicing or while near high pressure hydraulic systems Ensure all components are fully sealed and in good working order prior to operating the equipment.
- 7 Ensure all reflectors, lights and the safety triangle are clean prior to transportation on public roads¹ Check with local authorities to ensure you are compliant with all lighting requirements.

Maintenance Safety

In addition to reading and fully understanding this manual, you should:

- 1 Lower the land leveler, stop the tractor's engine, set controls to neutral, engage the emergency brake, remove the tractor's ignition key and wait for all moving parts to come to a full stop prior to adjusting, detaching or servicing the land leveler
- 2 Keep hands, feet, hair and all clothing away from all moving parts.
- 3 Clear the area of all people, especially small children, prior to engaging the land leveler and/or the tractor.
- 4 Place safety stands or blocks underneath the frame prior to removing the tires or working underneath the land lever.

- 5 Be extremely cautious while servicing or while near high pressure hydraulic systems Ensure all components are fully sealed and in good working order prior to operating the equipment. Wear appropriate safety gear to protect your eyes and hands Use a piece of wood or cardboard as a shield when examining a hose or fitting for a leak.
- 6 Always relieve pressure prior to disconnecting or servicing hydraulics.
- 7 Always use original parts when any need replacing.
- 8 Do not in any way modify this equipment, its components or its intended use Fabrication S.Houle inc. will not be held responsible should breakage or injury occur as a result of using any non-approved parts or accessories.
- 9 Do not operate equipment that is defective or that has parts missing.
- 10[†] Inspect nuts and bolts regularly and ensure they are tightly secure.

Hydraulic System Safety

- 1 Always set the hydraulic controls to neutral prior to disassembling the hydraulic system.
- 21 Be extremely cautious while servicing or while near high pressure hydraulic systems! Ensure all components are fully sealed and in good working order prior to operating the equipment. Wear appropriate safety gear to protect your eyes and hands! Use a piece of wood or cardboard as a shield when examining a hose or fitting for a leak.

Storage Safety

- 1 Store the land leveler in an area well away from human activity.
- 2) Store the land leveler in the lowered position.
- 3 Do not allow children to play near the stored land leveler

Tire Safety

- I Failure to follow appropriate directions while installing a tire on a wheel or rim may result in a blow-out, which could cause serious injury or death.
- 2ⁱ Never attempt to install a tire unless you have the materials and equipment required and have appropriate experience to do so
- 3 See a well known tire repair facility or dealer for any repair or maintenance work required.

Greasing

Locate the greasing decals (see illustration on right)


- 1 Use a manual grease gun
- 2 Clean the couplers and fittings with a clean cloth prior to lubricating
- 3 Replace and repair damaged or broken couplers
- 4 If couplers are difficult to lubricate, remove them so as to be able to clean them thoroughly, and replace them if necessary Also clean the lubricant passageway
- 5 Inject lubricant until the excess is expelled through the bearing or bushing areas.

Types of Lubricants

Grease

Use an SAE multi-purpose high temperature grease with extreme pressure (EP) performance A lithium-based SAE multi-purpose grease is also acceptable.


